Executive Director's Report

Week 7 Update - NWEA testing – We plan to have our teachers begin to administer these formative tests for grades K-8 and begin to dig a little deeper as to where our students are this stage of the year.

ELPAC testing – We have completed initial testing for new students to New Horizons.

Back to school night Oct 13th - This will be a virtual event this year.

Progress reports – These have been sent to parents and we are (5) weeks away from producing report cards for quarter number one.

Saturday Academies – If students have received failing marks in the first quarter, we will be providing additional tutoring support in our Saturday Academies, look for those dates in the near future.

LAUSD Board – In accordance with the larger district, we will begin vaccines for students 12 years old or older this November. We will provide parent notices, with the first doses beginning November 17th and a second vaccine to be given in December.

This is a site requirement at our co-location site. There are medical exemptions, but vaccines are required after the Winter date.

Some parents may push back, but the state and school district will press to keep kids on campus and will press us to move forward on the vaccine.

There will be no appointment necessary for the free vaccine, 1.5 months to get the first dose and these are geared toward our 7th-8th grade students
