## **September 2022 Financials**

- 1. Average Daily Attendance at The average *ADA* 256, attendance rate decreased by 14 students, rate of attendance 91.4%
- 2. Revenue our revenue is forecasted at \$5.3MM, decrease primarily due to
  - a. Net decrease in State Aid to enrollment, offset by increase in revenue related to hold harmless enrollment decline protection \$26K
  - b. Decrease in Federal and Other State revenue to enrollment decline \$57K
- 3. Total Expenditures forecasted at \$5.1MM, with a decrease by \$93K, primarily due to enrollment
- 4. Surplus forecasted at \$226K.
- 5. Ending Funding Balance \$1.9MM
- 6. Cash Balance \$1.9 MM, projected to \$1.4MM, end of year fiscal payments will include,
  - a. Repayment of Proposition 39 Energy Grant
  - b. Repayment of Prop 39 Facilities Settlement
